Chinese students help quake survivors

Dozens of students learning to speak Chinese at the Edmonton Chinese Bilingual Education Association raised money to help survivors of China's recent earthquake.

With the death toll from the earthquake now up to 70,000 people the students decided they needed to do something to help those who've survived.

"They said, 'why don't we do fundraising?' It's a get together for the parents and students, but it's also something that students can do and feel they can actually help out," said Edmonton Chinese Bilingual Education Association Director Stephen Tsang.

So far organizers say they have raised almost \$17,000 and they hope to raise another \$10,000.
